Innovation center looks for new chief

The Boulder Innovation Center will be looking for a new president over the next few weeks, someone who can take over when its current head, Doug Collier, steps down at the end of June to start a business with his wife.

Collier had been running the center as chairman and president since it launched two years ago.

Center board member Robert Gill, an experienced executive and longtime Boulder resident, is taking over as chairman of the BIC board. An interim team will run the search for a new president.

The innovation center is a collaboration between the city, Boulder's business community and the state to help local startups succeed. It has helped support the creation of 52 local jobs and attracted \$1.2 million in investment capital.
