Boulder Innovation Center Seeks New Executive Director

The Boulder Innovation Center (BIC) announced today that it is conducting a search for a new Executive Director. The Board of Directors is seeking a candidate with a proven entrepreneurial track record, strong ties to the Boulder and Colorado business community, and proven leadership experience in running and growing non-profit organizations. The Executive Director will be responsible for defining and executing a new three-year operating plan, which includes securing new sources of funding to expand the scope and reach of the BIC. Other high priorities will include maintaining and growing the Stage 2 Program (for early-stage companies that have completed a product launch and seeking to go to the next level), managing the BIC's relationship with the CU Technology Transfer Office (oriented to starting companies based on intellectual property created on the University of Colorado Boulder campus), and implementing educational outreach and community visibility programs. He or she will report to the Board of Directors and have strategic and operating control of the BIC, and will replace current Executive Director who will leave in August.

The BIC was established in 2005 as an alternative to traditional incubators. The Board of Directors consists of local entrepreneurs and business and community leaders. The BIC is funded by the State of Colorado, the City of Boulder, the Boulder Economic Council, the Boulder Chamber of Commerce, the University of Colorado Technology Transfer Office, and various other corporate sponsors and in-kind supporters. During its first two years of operation, the BIC has engaged 14 clients, created over 50 jobs, helped companies raise over \$1.2 million in capital and helped companies lease over 20,000 sq. feet of office space in Boulder County.
